You must respond to 4 bullet points. Each represents either the past, present, future or an opinion. You must know key phrases for each of these points.







Open-ended task + Complex language





32 marks + 2 bullet points.

You must respond to 2 bullet points. These are open ended. However, you must aim to include a range of tenses, opinions and complex language e.g. infinitive phrases, negatives, "desde hace", idioms, subjunctive.

TRANSLATION INTO SPANISH

High frequency language

12 marks + 50 word text

Every year high frequency words and phrases appear as well as the most common irregular verbs e.g. to be, to have, to go. See the "Spanish writing hacks" sheet for the full list.
